Since 90 years, each Ariston Group factory and company pays the same degree of attention to:

- ✓ provide safe and healthy working conditions for the prevention of work related injury and ill health for all employees and contractors
- ✓ operate in a responsible manner that respects the environment, avoiding commission of offences, also involuntary, against the environment

We believe that all injuries, safety incidents, occupational illnesses and environmental incidents are preventable by:

- ✓ eliminating hazards and reducing occupational health and safety risks
- ✓ complying with all applicable legal requirements
- ✓ consulting workers and their representatives for the definition of continuous improvement activities

In order to ensure continuous improvement, the Group has decided to design its management systems in accordance with the international standards ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 45001:2018 and to measure and assess, according to WCM methodology as well, its safety, health and environmental performances.

Furthermore, the Group expresses its commitment to mitigate climate change and its effects by defining a decarbonisation strategy and a monitoring system to reduce direct (Scope 1) and indirect (Scope 2 and Scope 3) emissions to achieve strategic ESG objectives towards 2030. With this purpose in mind, the Company will continue raising the efficiency of the way it operates across countries (plants and processes), designing and offering highly energy efficient solutions, which increasingly rely on renewable sources of energy, and improving the energy efficiency of its installed park.

This way of work will allow us to adhere to the highest standards, fulfilling needs and expectations of all interested parties and ensuring the safety and health of our Employees, our Customers, our Contractors and Suppliers and people of the communities in which we operate.

It is the responsibility of each employee to understand and promote this policy demonstrating responsible behaviour in daily activities and promptly informing management of any hazardous condition or opportunity for improvement.
